

COLORADO PROBLEM SOLVING COURT JUDGES

VOICE • The ability to be an active participant in the process; • The ability to express viewpoints/facts/opinions; and, • Active listening so they feel heard.

ACTIVE PARTICIPANT

- Provide opportunity to participate;
- Find opportunities to invite the litigant to tell his/her side of the
- Learn about specific cultural differences to avoid miscommunications;
- Explain to litigants how information can be presented; and,

EXPRESS THEMSELVES

- Explain to litigants how information can be presented;
- Where appropriate ask open ended questions;
- Ensure that all speakers in court speak clearly, while preventing people talking over each other; and,
- Consider ways to give voice to defendants, either directly or via their attorneys, during all hearings.

COLORADO PROBLEM SOLVING COURT JUDGES

TRANSPARENCY Introduce yourself; Explain why certain cases will be heard; Explain why what litigants or defendants can say is limited in time or scope; Explain sidebars; Go beyond rote colloquy questions; and, If a defendant seems unsure, offer a short recess so he/she can discuss with counsel.

COLORADO PROBLEM SOLVING COURT JUDGES

RESPECTFUL TREATMENT • Treated with dignity; • Rights are visibly and clearly protected; and, • Interactions are appropriate. Buts, Interactions are appropriate.

TREATED WITH DIGNITY Make appropriate eye contact; Acknowledge parties and witnesses by name; Treat all people in the courtroom courteously; and, Be sensitive to parties and witnesses' discomfort.

RIGHTS PROTECTED Treat all lawyers and litigants respectfully without favoritism; Explain what factors will be considered during sentencing; and, Describe the benefits of compliance and the consequences of noncompliance when outlining a sentence or order.

TRUSTWORTHY AUTHORITIES • Explain decisions; • Be sincere in the desire to help individuals; and, • Caring.

EXPLAIN DECISION

- When ruling repeat each sides' arguments;
- Ask defendants to repeat back what is expected of them;
- Describe the benefits of compliance and the consequences of noncompliance when issuing an order;
- Explain immediate next steps related all orders, including probation, intake or pre-trial release mandates; and,
- Convey to defendants and to the audience that it is in everyone's best interest if the defendant is able to successfully obey the order of the court.

BEING HELPFUL

- It's your order. You have a responsibility to explain it in understandable terms;
- When possible, use simple terms to explain your actions, reasons, and any consequences they may have for the person;
- Ask defendants to repeat back what is expected of them; and,
- Empower staff to be important representatives of your court through their interactions with the public.

COLORADO PROBLEM SOLVING COURT JUDGES

CARING Consider putting something on the bench as a mental reminder that patience is a virtue not always easily practiced; Demonstrate the interests and needs of all parties will be fairly considered; Emphasize that disputes will be resolved and rights will be protected; and, Communicate with the public in an open and ethical manner.

You Are The Key

"The mechanism by which....courts reduce substance use and crime is through participants' attitudes toward the judge. When participants have more positive attitudes toward the judge, they have better outcomes. This is true across all subgroups of participants when examining demographics, drug use history, criminality, and mental health."
